- VI. New & Old Business
 - A. Starlight Lease Negotiations
 - After speaking with representatives from Starlight, Ms. Diaz, CPA reported that Starlight requires a 10 year lease with an initial term of 5 years plus an



- additional 5 years at \$8. They are unwilling to commit to improvements to the rented space.
- ➤ Commissioner Jefferson suggested that the NORBP agree to 5 years at \$6 per square foot and renegotiate after 5 years."
- ➤ Commissioner Burbank raised the question, "If we are charging \$6, are we going to expect Starlight to make improvements?"
- > Discussion ensues.
- As a result of much discussion, it was *motioned by Commissioner Jarrett* and 2^{nd} by Commissioner Jefferson that the NORBP enter into contract with Starlight under the terms of \$6 per square foot for years 1-3, \$7 per square foot for years 4-5, and \$8 per square foot for years 6-10 plus a percentage of Starlight's gross income with no cap.

B. Nationwide Real Estate Report

- ➤ Mr. Green, Realtor, reported that he spoke with both a charter school regarding office space and tree cutting business regarding warehouse space most recently. Many interested tenants are waiting to fulfill their leases at their current spaces.
- ➤ Mr. Green also pitched the idea of resurrecting Virtual Office Suites, an incubator formerly operational at the NORBP Enterprise Center under the direction of Mr. Reuben DeTiege.
